RE: Progress Report Request

Dear Senator Sherrod Brown:

I am writing this letter in request to a progress report on the restoration of my natural and legal rights by which I am entitled as the natural rights of man, the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of Ohio, and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

We have been trying to clean up the mess that involves Federal Civil Rights Violations for quite some time. The longer it goes on unresolved, the more damage it causes. Every time another incidence is initiated, my wife and I end up in the crossfire. This has not only been burdensome to our financial security; it has caused devastating effects on our wellbeing as a whole.

Branches, Agencies, Jurisdiction, Authority, and Officers of the of the State of Ohio Government (hereinafter called the "State Government")

As you may recall, this entire catastrophe started with the embezzlement of \$150,000 of personal property in January of 1997 belonging to my brother and I as victims involving corruption within the State Government. Approximately another \$100,000 had also been embezzled over the following years, amounting to nearly \$250,000 in total. The dysfunctional State Government had also cost the victims approximately another \$250,000 of unnecessary legal expenses, a total loss of nearly \$500,000.

Oppression, Tyranny and Corruption within the State Government has now consumed more than fifteen years of our lives and damages well within seven figures. In June of 2006 I file a lawsuit for restitution against three agents and an official of the State Government in an attempt to recover my stolen Certificate of Deposit in the sum of \$100,000, interest, and other damages. I had also filed a Civil Rights lawsuit against three State Officials in violation of my Civil Rights. Due to the fact that several of the State Officials involved in the fifteen years of Fraud and Corruption were also involved in the abortion of these lawsuits "amounting to about 2% law and 98% politics".

Under the Laws of the Land I am entitled to the default judgments in awards as requested on my complaints filed against the defendants. Due to political interference and the miscarriage of justice within the State Government, I had been denied of my Natural and Legal Rights. Abuse of Power, Is the primary culprit involving gross deprivation of my Human Rights and entitlements; both the defendants and the State Officials all belong to the same mutually supportive clique within the State Government resulting in a dreadfully bias government and the prejudice of the plaintiff's rights to Procedural Due Process.

Excerpt from letter to my attorney handling creditor's lawsuits.

The biggest problem we are having right now would be the deprivation of Human Rights; this would include civil rights, civil liberties, natural rights, and legal rights. Under the rule of law and procedural due process there is an order of procedure that must be met not to violate the unalienable and legal rights of an individual. Both the State and Federal Governments are in violation of my Human Rights involving this case.

The State and Federal Governments cannot deprive me of my rights by which I am entitled as the natural rights of man and protected under the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of Ohio, and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Fourteenth Amendment

All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside. No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States; nor shall any State deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.

Ohio Constitution

All men are, by nature, free and independent, and have certain inalienable rights, among which are those of enjoying and defending life and liberty, acquiring, possessing, and protecting property, and seeking and obtaining happiness and safety.

Universal Declaration of Human Rights

Human rights abuse - Equality before the law or equality under the law or legal egalitarianism is the principle under which each individual is subject to the same laws, with no individual or group having special legal privileges. No one is exempt or included more than another. Article 7, of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

states that "All are equal before the law and are entitled without any discrimination to equal protection of the law."

One of the true measures of a democracy is its respect for the rights of its citizens, even in difficult times. I believe the protection of individual rights and liberties is a fundamental part of the oath of office I took to "support and defend the Constitution," an oath that itself is required by the Constitution. Throughout my career, in Columbus and Washington, I have opposed discrimination in every form and fought to **protect the civil rights and liberties of all citizens.**

I maintain a constant correspondence with the Federal Government; I work on this case everyday and send out dozens of e-mails/letters every week. The Federal Government has full priority over this case under federal statutes. The government does not e-mail and is reluctant to give out information until the case is complete. Due to the number of Human Rights violations; I have filed several complaints with several agencies and just the other day I filed another complaint under Human Rights law. In a nut shell, our hands are tied until the Federal Government completes my case and recovers my entitlements.

So as to your question on what to do... the plan still stands; the only thing we can do and that is wait for the Federal Government to complete the case and recover my entitlements. I have no other options at this time. Just as soon as the Federal Government recovers my entitlements everybody gets paid, we can settle all of the unsecured debts, pay off all the mortgages, and my wife and I can continue on with our lives in a somewhat normal way of life.

For any of the cases to proceed at this time would be just another violation of my Human Rights and forbidden under the laws of the land. These are just three out of dozens of issues that need to be resolved. Everyone is waiting on the Federal Government and I have no control over how fast they work.
